I have reviewed the Stanley R. Mickelsen Safeguard Complex, vicinity Nekoma, Cavalier County for National Register of Historic Places eligibility and found that the following features are eligible:

- Limited Area Sentry Station and Security Fence, 401
- Water Storage Reservoir, 420
- Heat Sink, 423
- Missile Site Control Building, 430
- Personnel, Equipment, and Utility Tunnel, 435
- Missile Site Radar (MSR) Power Plant, 440
- Universal Missile Building, 455
- Warhead Handling Building, 456
- Exclusion Area Sentry Station and Security Fence, 460
- Launch Area Utility Station, 470
- Spartan Launch Stations, 501-530
- Sprint Launch Stations, 541-556


