**ITEM DESCRIPTION AND INFORMATION ON INSPECTION AND REMOVAL**

DESCRIPTION: 30 FOOT TRIMARAN FLAT DECK BOAT

NAVY HULL REGISTRY NUMBER 30BP9716;

**FEATURES INCLUDE:** THIS IS A LARGE FLAT DECK WORK BOAT USED TO CARRY OIL POLLUTION BOOMS AND OTHER OIL POLLUTION EQUIPMENT. THE BOAT IS A TRIMARAN STYLE HULL WITH AN OFFSET CONTROL CONSOLE WITH A FWD SEAT WITH CUSHION. THERE IS A BUILT IN FUEL TANK, UNDER DECK STORAGE, HAND RAILS, MAGNETIC COMPASS, AND NAV LIGHTS. THE TWIN OUTBOARD ENGINES WERE REPORTED TO BE OPERATIONAL AT THE TIME OF INSPECTION; HOWEVER, THIS IS NOT A GUARANTEE THAT THEY WILL NOT REQUIRE REPAIR.
